

NASHUA RIVER RAMBLE RIDE

Cue Sheet and Map for Short Route (about 21 miles)

Part of this route rambles back and forth along the Nashua River Rail Trail from Nashua to Pepperell. Trail is shown as a dotted line in the map, below.

Ice Cream: You may want to stop for ice cream at an ice cream stand in Pepperell that caters to Rail Trail users. To get there, either take the Rail Trail to downtown Pepperell (the ice cream stand is across the street from the trail), or turn Right at mile 12.05 on to MA-113, and follow the highway in to Pepperell (the ice cream stand is on MA-113, across the street from the Rail Trail). To return to the Short route, follow MA-113 back to East St and turn Right, or follow the long route from the ice cream stand to the split at the intersection of East St and Jersey.

For ice cream after the ride, I recommend Sullivan Farms, at the intersection of Westford Rd and Rt 2A. To get there, follow Westford Rd back to Hwy 3, but keep going straight ahead on Westford Rd until it intersects 2A. Sullivan Farms will be on your Right.
